

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RIGHT TO INFORMATION COMMISSION, HELD ON 16TH NOVEMBER, 2016 REGARDING PRINTING OF PAMPHLETS, PIO REGISTERES AND INSTALLATION OF BILL BOARDS/HOARDING.

1/ A meeting of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Right to Information Commission was held on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 to examine the tenders which were invited for printing of Pamphlets, PIO Registers as well as awareness campaign through bill boards. The following participated:-

2/ Opening the discussion, the Chairman welcomed the participants and asked the Administrative Officer to brief the participants regarding the agenda of the meeting. The Administrative Officer explained that for keeping the general public constantly aware about the RTI Law, it was essential to print pamphlets for distribution. Similarly for keeping a record of the requests filed by citizens with PIOs all over the province, registers in sufficient number be printed and handed over to PIOs. In this regard tenders were floated in the newspapers, through the Information Department. For scrutiny of tenders, procurement committee was also constituted under the chairmanship of Professor Kalimullah Commissioner-II. The committee submitted its recommendations which are placed before the Commission for consideration and taking a decision.

3. The Commission after detailed discussion approved the recommendations of the procurement committee for award of contract to M/S Ishmal Traders for printing 800 pamphlets @ Rs. 2.50/- per pamphlet and printing of PIO registers to M/S Sky Vision Rs. 151.8/- per register.

4. The observations of the procurement committee regarding bill boards were discussed in detail. It was observed that M/S Apollo had offered the lowest rates and this firm was also registered with KPPRA, however they had not provided the call deposit. Another firm M/S Ishmal Traders had offered rates which were comparatively higher than M/S Apollo. This firm was also not registered with the KPPRA. However the Administrative Officer informed the Commission that M/S Apollo subsequently provided the call deposit.

5. After detailed deliberation it was decided that since M/S Apollo had offered the lowest rates and the firm also fulfilled other required conditions, hence, they should be awarded contract for installation of two Bill Boards (Hoardings) at the Peshawar Toll Plaza on the motorway and Shama Chowk, Peshawar Cantt.
