After having discussion with PIO and available record, it has been observed that about 37 Class IV employees having appointed by the then MS i.e. Dr. Akbar Zaman, without following the due process and the record has also been taken away by him. Dr. Akbar Zaman, was also summoned for personal hearing on 22.08.2024 to appear before the Commission and produce the record, but neither he attended the Commission nor produced the record to the Hospital Administration nor the Commission.

DECISION:

Having heard and examined the record produced by the Public Body in the instant case, the Commission decided that notice shall be served to the Director General, Health Services (DGHS), Peshawar to ensure the attendance of DHO Lakki Marwat, Dr. Akbar Zaman PMO Tajori Hospital and depute a Senior Officer of DGHS for next date of hearing.

It was further decided that an officer from Anti-Corruption Department shall be invited so as to probe the matter and decide the subject complaint on merit and ensure meritocracy and implementation of RTI Act, 2013 in DHQ Lakki Marwat in specific and Government Departments in general.
